

# Let the People Elect the Mayor – Not Councillors

To the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Stirling,

WE the undersigned electors of the City of Stirling in the state of Western Australian propose the following;

1. That the City of Stirling change the method of filling the office of Mayor from 2.11 (1. b) of the Local Government Act of 1995 to 2.11 (1. a) of the Act, to enable electors to choose the Mayor, rather than Councillors;
2. That the City of Stirling have this change implemented in sufficient time for the Local Government elections in October 2017;
3. That the Mayor NOT be a Councillor and perform duties (1. a) to ( 1. f) as listed in section 2.8 of the Local Government Act of 1995 and that 14 Councillors be retained to represent the very large number of residents and ratepayers in the City of Stirling.
