PETITION FOR LIVE VIDEO STREAMING OF COUNCIL MEETINGS

To the Mayor, Councillors and CEO of the City of Stirling

We the undersigned Residents & Ratepayers of the City of Stirling respectfully request that the City commence the live streaming of all Ordinary Council Meetings, Special Elector Meetings and General Elector Meetings (not necessarily Committee Meetings) as soon as possible.

Other councils in WA and around Australia have been videoing and live streaming public meetings for years. These councils include Bunbury, Joondalup and Vincent. This service enables residents who are unable to attend meetings to watch from their computers or phone at their convenience.

In-line with other councils we request that;

- 1. All public council meetings are live video streamed (in real time) using 4 cameras on the City's website;
- All videos of meetings are permanently archived in their entirety on the City's website, and that they be easily accessible, with individual links to the various parts and items of meetings as they are in meeting agendas.
- That all public questions, deputations and motions be included in the videos;
- 4. That video footage of meetings not be edited, tampered with or redacted by City staff. Community members watching online have the right to see and hear the same full meetings as those in attendance. Should a situation arise that requires the editing or a redaction of footage, the segment should be blurred and or silenced but not removed, and that a clearly stated reason for the omission be added.
